2011-2012 DRA Assessment Map Explanation

Because Performance Tracker cannot differentiate between fiction and nonfiction selections, we have come up with a number system to help us identify where students are struggling. This change is only for grades 3-5.

If the student has passed a DRA level...	Then you enter <u>THIS</u> into Performance Tracker.

Other important information:

- All grade levels need to enter reading scores 3 times per year at trimester **EXCEPT** 5th grade. 5th grade needs to complete the November and March assessments on **ALL** students. The June assessment is only for students **NOT** at a level 55 in March (50 Nonfiction).
- Please keep **ALL** completed DRA forms in the students' folders for next year's teacher to see. You can throw away DRA forms that previous teachers have completed.
- The score entered into Performance Tracker should be the Independent Level – or the level the student passed. Assessment should go on until a student fails so the teacher knows where to instruct.
